Greene Township Board of Supervisors Vacancy

Greene Township, Pike County, PA consists of a three (3) member board of supervisors, elected by the electors of the township.

Due to a death, there is a vacancy on the board of supervisors. Per the Second Class Township Code, Article IV, Section 407 (a), *“If the electors of any township fail to choose a supervisor, tax collector or auditor, or if any person elected to any office fails to serve in the office, or if a vacancy occurs in the office by death, resignation under subsection (b), removal from the township or otherwise, the board of supervisors may appoint a successor who is a registered elector of the township and has resided in that township continuously for at least one year prior to their appointment.”*

The remaining members of the board of supervisors are accepting applications to fill this vacancy. The person selected would serve until the first Monday in January after the first municipal election which occurs at least sixty days after the vacancy occurs, at which election an eligible person shall be elected for the unexpired term. The next election year is 2023.

Interested parties can submit a one (1) page application to the board of supervisors for consideration which includes:

1. Name, physical address, email address & telephone number.
2. A brief description of why one has interested in serving on the board of supervisors.
3. Description of why one believes he/she is best suited for this position.
4. How any education and/or skills will serve the residents of Greene Township.

Applications should be submitted no later than Wednesday, May 18, 2022 at 2:00pm, either:
